THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S INTERNATIONAL AWARD NEWFOUNDLAND & LABRADOR

The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award is the world's leading non-formal education qualification. It is based on the idea that developing everyday practical life skills through experiential learning will help equip young people for life and work. It is a tool for working with youth, to help them set and achieve goals and guide them on their journey into Adulthood.

Each Award represents a progressive challenge, where the commitment becomes greater at each level and each Award section represents a different area of personal development.

The development and continuance of the social, physical and emotional habits that are fostered through the Award not only benefit our youth participants but also have long-term benefits to our community and province. The Award develops in young people the power skills, durable skills, human skills, people skills.
